## ORDER

WHEREAS the University Grants Commission has issued guidelines for pursuing two academic programmes simultaneously vide D.O. letter No. 1-6/2007 (CPP – II) (New) dated 13<sup>th</sup> April, 2022.

WHEREAS the abovesaid guidelines allow the students to pursue two academic programmes simultaneously keeping in view the following objectives envisaged in NEP 2020:

- Recognizing, identifying, and fostering the unique capabilities of each student, by sensitizing teachers as well as parents to promote each student's holistic development in both academic and non-academic spheres;
- No hard separations between arts and sciences, between curricular and extracurricular activities, between vocational and academic streams, etc. in order to eliminate harmful hierarchies among, and silos between different areas of learning.
- Multidisciplinary and a holistic education across the sciences, social sciences, arts, humanities, and sports for a multidisciplinary world in order to ensure the unity and integrity of all knowledge;
- Enabling an individual to study one or more specialized areas of interest at a deep level, and also develop character, ethical and constitutional values, intellectual curiosity, scientific temper, creativity, spirit of service.
- Offering the students, a range of disciplines including sciences, social sciences, arts, humanities, languages, as well as professional, technical, and vocational subjects to make them thoughtful, well-rounded, and creative individuals.
- Preparing students for more meaningful and satisfying lives and work roles and enable economic independence.

WHEREAS the said guidelines need to be implemented for the students of University and affiliated colleges.

And the matter is required to be regulated by the ordinances as provided under section 73(i) of Maharashtra Public Universities Act, 2016 and in absence of the same and considering the exigency of the matter for the time being and pursuant to the decision of the University Authority dated 18<sup>th</sup> December, 2021, issuance of the directions by the Vice-Chancellor under section 12(8) of Maharashtra Public Universities Act, 2016 is necessary.

Therefore I, Prof. Digambar Tukaram Shirke, Vice-Chancellor, Shivaji University, Kolhapur hereby regulate the matter in respect of the UGC guidelines for pursuing two academic programmes simultaneously by issuing following directions in exercise of powers conferred upon me by section 12(8) of the Maharashtra Public Universities Act 2016,.



The UGC guidelines for pursuing two academic programmes simultaneously shall be made applicable to the students, pursuing academic programmes other than Ph.D. programme in the University, affiliated college and recognized institution.


It is further clarified that the existing ordinance, which is not inconsistent with the UGC Guidelines, shall remain in force.

The guidelines for pursuing two academic programmes simultaneously shall be...

1. A student can pursue two full time academic programmes in physical mode provided that in such cases, class timings for one programme do not overlap with the class timings of the other programme.
2. A student can pursue two academic programmes, one in full time physical mode and another in Open and Distance Learning (ODL)/Online mode; or up to two ODL/Online programmes simultaneously.
3. Degree or diploma programmes under ODL/Online mode shall be pursued with only such HEIs which are recognized by UGC/Statutory Council/Govt. of India for running such programmes.
4. Degree or diploma programmes under these guidelines shall be governed by the Regulations notified by the UGC and also the respective statutory/professional councils, wherever applicable.
5. These guidelines shall come into effect from the date of this order. No retrospective benefit can be claimed by the students who have already done two academic programmes simultaneously prior to the notification of this order.

**The above guidelines shall be applicable only to the students pursuing academic programmes other than Ph.D. programmes.**
